- 1. Program has to apply
- 2. Program has to submit detailed agenda/course outline
- 3. Program has to identify faculty
- 4. Program has to detail materials, handouts, etc
- 5. Program would have to state profit or non-profit. (This is important because of our non-profit status and the restrictions on partnering with a for profit)
- 6. Program would have to agree to link AELE on their website (It must be a two way street)
- 7. Program would have to certify attendance for anyone seeking CLS designation
- 8. Program must meet minimum day/hour requirement
- 9. Program must relate to what we do

The motion failed for the lack of a second.

No action was taken.
